Title :	The Charging Standard of Using Government Information Provided by the Veterans Affairs Council and Its Subordinate Agencies Ch

Content :	<p>Article 1</p> <p>This Standard is enacted according to paragraph 2 of Article 22 of “the Openness of Government Information Act” (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”).</p> <p>Article 2</p> <p>The fees for reading, copying, transcribing, or photographing public records and/or government publications are NT\$20 for every two hours. Time spent less than two hours is counted as two hours.</p> <p>Article 3</p> <p>The fees for duplicating or copying public records or government publications shall be charged in accordance with the Charging Standard Table of duplicating or copying government information (as the attached table.)</p> <p>The items undefined in the above Charging Standard Table shall be charged in accordance with the actual costs of duplication or copying.</p> <p>File: The Charging Standard Table of Duplicating or Copying Government Information.doc</p> <p>Article 4</p> <p>When mailing service is required in addition to duplication or copying of government information, the postage shall be charged according to the actual expense.</p> <p>Article 5</p> <p>The applicant that requests the government information for academic research or public interest use shall state the purpose, object, content, use, and effectiveness, and attach the relevant documentary proof. After the request is approved, the fee shall be halved except for the actual mailing expenses.</p> <p>Article 6</p> <p>The requested government information that falls within the scope of business handling or educational promotions as defined in paragraph 1,Article 12 of the “Charges and Fees Act” may be provided free of charge.</p> <p>Article 7</p>

The collection of fees as listed in this Standard shall comply with the budgetary procedures.

Article 8

This Standard shall take effect on the date of its promulgation.
