Title :	Organization Act of Veterans General Hospitals <a href="#">Ch</a>

Legislative :	1.Promulgated on July 3, 2013 and enforced on November 1, 2013
Content :	<p>Article 1</p> <p>The Veterans Affairs Council shall establish the Veterans General Hospital (hereinafter referred to as “VGH” ) to administer the veterans’ medical care and healthcare, medical services for public, medical professionals training, and medical research and development. In principle, VGH shall be named in locus.</p> <p>Article 2</p> <p>VGH shall be in charge of the following matters:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Veterans’ medical care and healthcare.</li><li>2. Public’ s medical care and healthcare.</li><li>3. Medical professionals’ research and training.</li><li>4. Cooperation with other hospitals and research institutes on medicine and medical affairs.</li><li>5. Rehabilitation and medical care for people with disabilities.</li><li>6. Supervision, coordination and implementation of VGH branches.</li><li>7. Handling other affairs related to practice of medicine, operation and management.</li></ol> <p>Article 3</p> <p>VGH shall have one Superintendent, concurrently served by Class I senior ranking physician in accordance with the Medical Personnel Regulation; and 2 to 5 Deputy Superintendents, served by Class I senior ranking medical personnel in accordance with the Medical Personnel Act.</p> <p>Article 4</p> <p>VGH shall have one Secretary General ranked as Senior Grade 10 to 11.</p> <p>Article 5</p> <p>The ranks, grades and classifications and number of positions of VGH staff shall be governed by the personnel establishment table.</p> <p>Article 6</p> <p>This Act shall come into force on the date of the Executive Yuan’ s order.</p>
